YEAR IN REVIEW

We are extremely grateful for the support that we have secured from the Charlotte community as we stand poised in 2026 to significantly grow the help that we can give young adults in Charlotte that are fighting cancer. As we enter our fifth year, we are establishing relationships in the cancer community that will help facilitate that growth.



Our year began with our 5th annual “The Meggs” Golf Classic which is held in April of each year. We have been blessed with the support from 10 legacy sponsors at this event and the participation of 144 golfers and 30 volunteers. The event raised over \$75,000.

In September, we were one of two beneficiaries of the fourth annual ForkCancer dinner gala that highlights the work of local non-profits in Charlotte that are helping patients in their fight against cancer. Our portions of the proceeds were \$30,000. ForkCancer has rebranded to Chefs Against Cancer, and the The Meggs Foundation will be one of three recipients of their 2026 funding.

At the end of the year Invited Clubs used its annual Charity Classic at TPC Piper Glen to host a 72-person Member Guest that generated another \$6,500 for our Foundation.

Lastly, we received a grant from the 24 Foundation of \$15,000 in recognition of our year-long contribution to Charlotte’s cancer community.

OPERATING MODEL

Our operating model has been driven by our ongoing relationship with Levine Cancer Institute. We work with 19 Nurse and Financial Navigators at Levine who identify patients that meet our criteria for financial assistance. Over 95 percent of our patients come from Levine Cancer Institute and the rest come from referrals from Hope Abounds, Nothing Pink and Teal Diva as well as online applications through word of mouth.

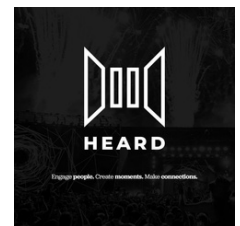
